**I. Scale Description**

The *Inventory of Parent Experiences* is a 38-item measure that explores a parent's social support network and assesses satisfaction with parenting. The Inventory has two parts: *Social Support* and *Parenting Satisfaction*.

*Social Support* (items 1 to 19) characterize the parent's support network, including: size of the network, types of network members, closeness of the parent's relationships, quality and stability of the spousal/partner relationship, helpfulness of network members, effect of the parent's job on family life, and frequency of the parent's own social opportunities. Responses for the Social Support items are of different types: *quantity*, *level of satisfaction*, *frequency*, *positive/negative effect*, *yes/no*, and multiple *nominal choices* (e.g., "Your partner," "Your parents," "Brothers or sisters.") Sixteen responses are coded on a four-point scale (zero to three) and three responses are coded on a two-point scale (0 and 1). No obvious method of scoring *Social Support* exists; more analysis is needed before scoring protocols can be established.

*Parenting Satisfaction* (items 20 to 38) assesses satisfaction with the parent's social life, support network, and "life situation," including: the parent's amount of social contact, amount of household responsibility, parenting chores, personal relationships, availability of parenting support, the effect of employment on

other parts of the parent’s life, and the parent’s life in general. Responses are coded on a four-point scale and include: “Very dissatisfied (0),” “Somewhat dissatisfied (1),” “Somewhat satisfied (2),” and “Very satisfied (3).”

## II. Report Sample

These analyses were conducted on the first cohort on the high-risk sample (n = 310) and the normative sample (n = 387 with overlap, total N = 618) from the first year of the study. Two records are missing the complete measure. One record from Nashville and one record from Washington were missing from the normative sample. Individual items that do not apply to a respondent also have missing answers; for example, respondents who are not employed did not answer items 36 to 38 which ask about the parent’s job.

## III. Scaling

A previous study attempted to identify subscales for the entire *Inventory of Parent Experiences* (Items 1 to 38). In that study, the analyses combined items with different response metrics, such as *level of satisfaction, frequency, and yes/no*. As a result, concerns exist about the subscales that emerged from the study, particularly for the Social Support portion.

*Parenting Satisfaction* four subscales: *Community Satisfaction* (Items 27 and 28), *Friendship Satisfaction* (Items 29 to 31), *Family Satisfaction* (Items 32 to 34), and *Parental Role Satisfaction* (Items 20 to 26). Each subscale score is calculated as the mean of responses. The single Item 38 assesses “General Life Satisfaction.” Items 35, 36 and 37 are not included in any subscale. Only employed respondents answered Items 36 to 38.

*Cronbach’s alphas were calculated for each subscale and are shown in the table below:*

Three of the subscales – *Friendship Satisfaction, Family Satisfaction and Parental Role Satisfaction* – showed adequate reliability for both the high-risk and normative samples. *Community Satisfaction*, while showing lower reliabilities for the high-risk and normative samples, is composed of only two items.

The *Social Support* portion was not scored. The following tables contain the frequency of responses for Items 1 to 19 for the normative and high-risk groups. Item 9, which has four discrete answers, is broken into four parts for frequency calculation purposes.

#### IV. Differences Between Groups

A series of t-tests between the high-risk sample (not including the overlap) and the normative sample indicated significant differences for two subscales, *Family Satisfaction* and *Parent Role Satisfaction*, with the normative sample scoring higher than the high-risk sample for both scores. There were no significant differences between the control and intervention samples on the four subscales.

Four items, 35, 36, 37 and 38, were not included in any scale. Item 35 (satisfaction with the availability of someone to share private feelings with) and Item 38 (satisfaction with entire current life situation), indicated significant differences between the normative and high-risk samples. The normative sample was more likely to indicate higher satisfaction on these items compared to the high-risk sample. There were no significant differences between the control and intervention samples on the four items.
