I. <u>Survey Description</u>

Friend Survey of Couples in Wave XIX is a 6-item derived from Straus' Conflict Tactics. However, the wording of items and values differ from the original questions applied to partners. The Friend Couples Survey measure frequency of occurrence of things a Fast Track respondent might have done to his/her partner as being reported by a nominated friend. The frequency values are: never, once, twice, 3-5 times and more than 5 times.

II. Report Sample

These analyses were conducted on friends nominated by respondents of the first cohort on the high-risk control sample (n = 96) and the normative sample (n = 195) for the nineteenth year of the study. The distribution of respondents by site was as follows: for the control sample, 20 were from Durham, 20 were from Nashville, 28 were from Pennsylvania and 19 were from Washington. For the normative sample, 56 were from Durham, 44 were from Nashville, 58 were from Pennsylvania and 37 were from Washington. A screener question is used to establish eligibility for the Friend Couples Survey questions. The sample was reduced to 243 friends of respondents who reported having a partner.

III. Scaling

A single scale was constructed using 4 items reporting inter-partner physical violence (questions Q341-Q344). The scale for this report was constructed for both the Normative and High-Risk Control samples. The scores were calculated by taking an average of the items comprising the scale. None of the observations were missing 50% or more data. The resulting scale, items that compose it and internal consistencies (Cronbach's coefficient Alpha) are provided below. Comparison of means for the single scale between high and low risk respondents was found significant (p<.01).

V. Recommendations for Use

The scale constructed for Friend Couples Survey has good reliability. The user is encouraged to test for associations for variables measuring individual items derived from Straus' Conflict Tactics measure. For these individual variables (f19g339 – f19g344), the presence of missing values should be noted.
