I. Scale Description

The Inventory of Parent Experiences is a 38-item measure that explores a parent's social support network and assesses satisfaction with parenting. The Inventory has two parts: Social Support and Parenting Satisfaction.

The Social Support items (1-19) characterize the parent's support network, including: size of the network, types of network members, closeness of the parent's relationships, quality and stability of the spousal/partner relationship, helpfulness of network members, effect of the parent's job on family life, and frequency of the parent's own social opportunities. Responses for the Social Support items are of different types: quantity, level of satisfaction, frequency, positive/negative effect, yes/no, and multiple nominal choices (e.g., "Your partner," "Your parents," "Brothers or sisters.") Sixteen responses are coded on a four-point scale (zero to three) and three responses are coded on a two-point scale (0 and 1). No obvious method of scoring the Social Support portion exists; more analysis is needed before scoring protocols can be established.

The Parenting Satisfaction items (20-38) assess satisfaction with the parent's social life, support network, and "life situation," including: the parent's amount of social contact, amount of household responsibility, parenting chores, personal relationships, availability of parenting support, the effect of employment on other parts of the parent's life, and the parent's life in general. Responses are coded on a four-point scale and include "Very dissatisfied (0)," "Somewhat dissatisfied (1)," "Somewhat satisfied (2)," and "Very satisfied (3)."

II. Report Sample

This report contains data collected on Cohort 1, Year 2. The data include a high-risk control sample (n=155) and a normative sample (n = 387) for a total n = 463, including overlap.

Thirty-one of the 463 are missing responses for the entire Inventory, including 24 from the normative group (three from Durham, twelve from Washington, three from Pennsylvania, and six from Nashville), and eight from the control group (four from Durham and four from Washington). Individual items that do not apply to a respondent also have missing answers; for example, respondents who are not employed did not answer items 36 to 38 which ask about the parent's job.

III. Scaling

A previous study attempted to identify subscales for the entire Inventory of Parent Experiences (items 1-38). In that study, the analyses combined items with different response metrics, such as *satisfaction level*, *frequency*, and *yes/no*. As a result, concerns exist about the subscales that emerged from the study, particularly for the Social Support portion.

The Parenting Satisfaction portion has four subscales: *Community Satisfaction* (items 27 and 28), *Friendship Satisfaction* (items 29-31), *Family Satisfaction* (items 32-34), and *Parental Role Satisfaction* (items 20-26). Each subscale score is calculated as the mean of responses. A single item (38) also assesses "General Life Satisfaction." (Only employed respondents answered item 38.) Items 35 and 36 are not included in any subscale.

The alpha coefficients for the normative sample and control sample are:

The Social Support portion of the Inventory was not scored. The following tables contain the frequency of responses for items 1 to 19 for the normative and high-risk control groups. Item nine, which has four discrete answers, is broken into four parts for frequency calculation purposes.

V. Recommendations for Use

T-tests of means for three of the subscales on the Parenting Satisfaction portion show a significant difference between the normative and high-risk control groups. However, each subscale includes only a small number of items and most of the scales have modest reliability.
