I. Scale Description

The Parent Questionnaire evaluates parenting practices that are often the focus of parent training programs. The Parent Questionnaire is derived from a scale developed by Strayhorn and Weidman (1988).

The Parent Questionnaire contains 27 items. Twenty-three items describe a situation or interaction that occurs with parents and children; for example, "Of all the times that you talk to your child about his or her behavior, what fraction is praise?" Two items contain statements about the parent's confidence and general ability in managing the child. The remaining two items explore how consistently two parents agree about discipline practices.

For each item, the parent selects the response that estimates the frequency of the interaction. Each item uses one of two response scales. Response choices include: "Never" (0); "Less than half the time" or "About once a week or less" (1); "About half the time" or "More than once a week, but less than once a day" (2); "More than half the time" or "One or two times day" (3); and "All the time" or "Many times each day" (4).

II. Report Sample

This report contains data collected on Cohort 1, Year 3. The data include a high-risk control sample (n=155) and a normative sample (n = 387) for a total n = 463, including overlap. Forty-three of the 463 are missing responses for the entire Neighborhood Questionnaire, including 30 from the normative group (5 from Durham, 8 from Washington, 7 from Pennsylvania, and 10 from Nashville), and 13 from the control group (4 from Durham, 2 from Nashville, 3 from Pennsylvania, and 4 from Washington), with overlap between the normative and control groups. These measures are not included in the analyses. Single-parent respondents have missing answers for items 24 and 25, which assess inter-parental consistency.

III. Scaling

A previous study of the Parent Questionnaire (1996) identified four subscales listed in the table below.

Items 21 and 22* are associated with Parenting Efficacy, but were not correlated (1996). Items 1 and 7 are not included on any subscale.

V. Recommendations for Use

T-tests of means on the Parent Questionnaire show significant differences between the normative and control groups for Appropriate/Consistent Discipline, Warmth/Involvement , and Harsh/Physical Discipline subscales, and for Items 7, 21, and 22. For both the normative and control groups, the Harsh/Physical Discipline subscale is slightly skewed in a positive direction. For the Harsh/Physical Discipline subscale, 65% of the control group's scores are between .5 and 1.0, within a score range of .25 to 3.00, and a mean of 0.93. Analysts should also note that the alpha coefficients for the Harsh/Physical Discipline subscale are low.
