I. Scale Description

The SACA (Stiffman et al., 2000) was used by Fast Track to collect parents' reports of their children's mental health service-use history. The instrument asks a maximum of 331 questions on service use by their child (plus 10 introductory demographic questions). The initial 24 of the 331 are 'gate-level' questions which ask the parent about the child's lifetime use covering 23 different categories of inpatient

and outpatient service use. If the parent indicates that their child had never received any services in the presented categories, they would only be asked these initial 24 questions. A positive response on lifetime service-use for a particular category (e.g., psychiatric hospital) would lead to a separate section that asked more in-depth questions about service use in the past 12 months for that category, including when child first received services, name and address of most recent service provider, total number of days served, child's reaction to service, who referred child to service and how the service was paid for. The number and type of follow-up questions might vary slightly between categories. The original version of the SACA was only used in year-7 for cohorts 1 and 2.

In year-8, a very brief/temporary questionnaire consisting of 27 items culled from the original instrument was given in place of the original SACA (labeled as the "Brief SACA Interview"). This version was only given to cohort 1. Sample/missing data characteristics will be the only information presented on this brief version in this technical report.

In year-9, a new survey of service use ("Services Instrument") was created by the Fast Track Project which was based on the original SACA. This version asks the parent a possible total of 154 questions covering 17 categories of service use. As with the original SACA, parents are asked a minimum of one question per category and answer more detailed questions if they indicate that their children had experience with a particular service-type. Questions within categories are similar to the original SACA (e.g., extent of service use in past year, amount of money spent on services, payment sources (type of insurance, how much family paid, etc.), address information for facilities/providers used). One distinction between this new version and the old version of the SACA is that, in the newer version, service-use is recorded regardless of whether the child was seen for emotional/behavioral problems. Within general health-type service categories (e.g., emergency room or family doctor), a separate question asks the parent if the child's visit was for emotional/behavioral reasons to help distinguish reasons for service use.

II. Report Sample

Numbers presented on this instrument involve the Cohort 1 normative and high-risk samples in years 7-9 (N=463).

Original SACA: 391 families (84.4%) provided data for the year-7 SACA. In the low-risk group, 254 subjects had data while 54 (17.5%) were missing data; in the high-risk group, 137 provided data while 18 (11.6%) were missing this data. Examination of missing data by site revealed that Durham was missing 14 of 125 (11.2%) from the total sample, Nashville was missing 13 of 105 (12.4%), Penn was missing 18 of 124 (14.5%) and Seattle was missing 27 of 109 (24.8%).

Brief SACA: 283 families provided data while 180 (38.9%) of the sample are missing data on this instrument. Of the low-risk group, 184 subjects provide data while 124 (40.3%) are missing. Of the high-risk group, 99 subjects provided data while 56 (36.1%) were missing. Out of the total sample, Durham was missing 13 of 125 (10.4%), Nashville was missing 23 of 105 (21.9%), and Seattle was missing 22 of 109 (20.2%). For unknown reasons, only 2 of the 124 subjects at Penn were given the Brief SACA. Because of the degree of missing data on this instrument at one site in addition to the limited amount of information, these data will probably not be of much use for analyses. No further statistics will be presented for the Brief SACA in this technical report.

Services Instrument (Not-So-Brief SACA): 368 cohort-1 families provided data in year-9 for the Services Instrument, while 95 (20.5%) of the sample are missing data. Of the low-risk group, 242 subjects provided data while 66 (21.4%) are missing. Of the high-risk group, 126 subjects provided data while 29 (18.7%) were missing. For the total sample by site, Durham was missing 18 of 125 (14.4%), Nashville was missing 33 of 105 (31.4%), Penn was missing 20 of 124 (16.1%) and Seattle was missing 24 of 109 (22.0%).

III. Scaling

No scales were derived for this instrument.

IV. Differences Between Groups

Group differences are most effectively observed through the 2 x 2 contingency table of high-risk status by lifetime service use (whether or not the child has used a certain type of service). Chi-square statistics were generated to test group differences. All results below are based on unweighted frequencies. Only results for questions on lifetime service use are presented here for the sake of brevity and because lifetime questions are the only ones for which there are data for everyone who received the SACA.

Original SACA: Significant differences existed between low- and high-risk subjects regarding likelihood of service use for emotional, behavioral, drug or alcohol problems (within lifetime) in the following categories. In all cases, the high-risk group had a higher prevalence rate of service use: Overnight in a Psychiatric Hospital, Help from a Mental Health Center, Help from a Mental Health Professional, Help from an In-Home Therapist, Help from a Family Doctor, Help from a Self-help Group, Help from a School Counselor ($p<.001$); Overnight in a General Hospital, Overnight in an Emergency Shelter, Help from a Day Treatment Center, ($p<.05$). High-risk children were also significantly more likely to have had police intervention ($p<.001$). Overall, significant differences at (at least) the $p<.05$ level occurred in 11 of 24 service categories. Due to the low amount of response on the 12-month service use assessment, results for those variables are not presented here.

Services Instrument: High- and low-risk groups also showed several significant differences in the rate of services use in year 9. Chi-square tests revealed that high-risk children were significantly more likely than low-risk children to have ever used Inpatient mental health services, Outpatient mental health services, or Special-Ed services from their school ($p<.001$). For specific lifetime service use questions, high-risk children had a significantly higher rate of use ($p<.001$, except where noted) in the following categories: Overnight in a Psychiatric Hospital, Overnight in Other Facility ($p<.05$), Help from a Mental Health Center, Help from a Day Treatment Center, Help from an In-Home Therapist/Family Preservationist, Help from a Other Counselor/Therapist, Help from a School Counselor, and Police Contact. Overall, for the lifetime service-use questions significant differences occurred in 8 of 17 categories in the revised version of the SACA.

V. Recommendations for Use

The SACA/Services Instrument data provides much information on mental health service use. Besides lifetime service use, it solicits more detailed information regarding recent service use (past 12 months) if the subject has indicated service use at some point in the lifetime, as described above. Analysts can examine group differences in degree and pattern of mental health service use as well as examine the relationship between characteristics of service use with predictors from other instruments. Data recording names/addresses of providers will allow for following up and seeking more detailed information for specific subjects regarding what services were delivered and how these services were paid for.

Reported use of services is somewhat limited in early years of the SACA, especially in more specialized service categories. This is especially true for the 12-month questions. Analysts should note the degree of response for services before generating descriptive statistics or using outcomes in statistical models. In general, most distributions will be 'zero-modal' so examination of distribution characteristics is highly advised.

There are also several logistical problems with the original SACA data at the time of this technical report. First, variables are inconsistent as to their numeric/character status. Binary indicators of service use are often character and had to be converted in order to generate usage rates (presented below). Inconsistencies in variable-types (as to their numeric/character status) between cohorts also lead to merging problems between cohorts, including such basic variables as the COHORT variable. Also,

subjects' data for service use in the past 12-months is set to missing if that subject had indicated they had never received that service; thus, 12-month data has misleadingly high rates of missing data, even though those subjects truly did not receive services in the past 12-months. These missing values (for subjects who indeed did receive the SACA) should be set to zero in order to obtain accurate 12-month rates of service use.
