## I. Scale Description

The Vanderbilt Mental Health Self Efficacy Questionnaire was developed and used by Bickman and his colleagues (1991) as part of the Family Empowerment Project. The measure consists of 25 Likert scale items measuring parents' self efficacy beliefs and behavioral expectations about obtaining and participating in mental health treatment for their children. Self efficacy is a parent's assessment of his or her ability to meet a desired goal. Parents rate each item from strongly agree (1) to strongly disagree (5). The statements associated with the items are listed in the tables below.

Whether or not parents receive this measure depended on their responses in the Service Assessment for Children and Adolescents (SACA) measure. The VMHSEQ is only administered if a parent reported in the SACA that their child received services from at least one of the following facilities/providers:

- a psychiatric hospital
- a general hospital for emotional, behavioral, or drug/alcohol problems
- a residential treatment center
- a group home
- some other overnight facility for emotional, behavioral, or drug/alcohol problems
- a mental health care center
- day treatment or partial hospitalization

- a drug and/or alcohol treatment center
- care from an in-home therapist or family preservation worker
- respite care
- care from a counselor or therapist

In year 11/grade10, this measure was erroneously given to all parents in cohort 1, regardless of their responses to the SACA questions described above. The analyses in this report, however, only include the parents who were supposed to be given the VHMSEQ measure.

# II. <u>Report Sample</u>

These exploratory analyses were conducted with the control sample (n=155) and the normative sample (n=387, N=463 with overlap) from the first cohort during the eleventh year of the study. Overall, 376 records were missing the whole measure, however, this is not surprising given that the VMHSEQ was only given to a subset of the sample whose child received mental health services. One Hundred and two respondents were missing from the control sample (28 from Durham, 31 from Nashville, 22 from Pennsylvania, and 21 from Washington) and 333 respondents were missing from the normative sample (87 from Durham, 89 from Nashville, 86 from Pennsylvania, and 71 from Washington).

## III. Scaling

Following the procedure developed by Bickman and his colleagues (1998), the 25 items in this measure are combined to create one scale capturing a parent's self efficacy regarding mental health services for their child. The 25 Likert items are summed together after the values for several of the items are reversed such that higher values indicate higher levels of self efficacy. The reversed items include: P12AF7, P12AF9, P12AF10, P12AF11, P12AF12, P12AF15, P12AF16, P12AF19, P12AF22, P12AF23, P12AF25, P12AF27, P12AF30.

Cronbach's alpha was calculated for the subscale and is shown in the table below:

The Vanderbilt Mental Health Self Efficacy Scale has a high level of reliability for internal consistency in both samples.

## IV. Differences Between Groups

The t-test results, displayed below, reveal that the mean *Vanderbilt Mental Health Self Efficacy Scale* scores are not statistically different for the high risk control and normative samples.

Among the individual items, the means for three items are statistically significantly higher for the normative sample relative to the high risk control sample. These items include:

- Parents like me can change the course of our children's treatment if we make ourselves heard (P11AF17)
- Reversed: No matter how hard I try, my child won't get the mental health services that my child needs (P11AF15r)
- I know that I can do what needs to be done to work with my child's mental health services (P11AF8)

The Mental Health Self Efficacy Scale has high reliability and has a normal distribution when the one outlier with a value of 37 is excluded from the sample. See Bickman, Heflinger, Northrup, Sonnichsen, & Schilling (1998) for an example of its use.
